Kick-off on Saturday, September 17 from 9:00-12:00 at Rosa's Office Plus. Cope Environmental Center and Rosa's Office Plus will be partnering with Asset Recovery & Recycling and Shred Monkey to offer Monthly E-Waste Recycling. Bring your e-waste, used toner cartridges, old cell phones, and documents to shred and recycle them at Rosa's on Saturday, September 17 – see attached list of items being accepted. This is a free service to the community!

**According to [www.dosomething.org](http://www.dosomething.org) -**

The United States dumps between 300 million and 400 million electronic items per year, and less than 20% of that e-waste is recycled. This is 70% of the overall toxic waste, including lead, found in landfills. About 50 million cell phones are replaced worldwide each month, and only 10% are recycled. That amounts to a huge amount of useful items that could be reused instead of going into the landfills. Recycling these items ensures toxic materials are properly disposed of and some to even be recycled along with the plastic and metal components found in e-waste.
