## Shopping List

### **Communities In Schools Of Wayne County**

- \$10 provides one at risk student with information about college success and enrollment
- \$25 provides one at-risk student an hour with a caring adult
- \$50 provide 2 hours of leadership training for parents

### **Community Food Pantry**

- \$10 feeds 2 children for a week
- \$25 feeds a family of 4 for a week
- \$50 buys approximately 357 lbs of food for the Community Food Pantry to distribute

### **Cope Environmental Center**

- \$10 to help support and celebrate volunteers!
- \$25 to help maintain scenic trails for hiking and educational programs!
- \$50 to help create new environmental education curricula for school and summer programs!

### **Friends of Morrisson-Reeves Library**

- \$10 provides craft materials for children's program
- \$20 provides books and materials for summer reading program
- \$50 sponsors a storytime for toddlers

### **Girls Inc. of Wayne County**

- \$15 enables our girls to lead into their future, with a service learning opportunity for our 6-8 yr olds
- \$30 helps our girls see beyond the message and into their heart, providing 1 hour of media literacy education
- \$50 builds hope in our girls, providing one integrated age session with a hands on creative activity

### **Hand In Hand Adult Day Care**

- \$10 provides supplies and snacks for one adult
- \$35 provides a half day of caring service for one adult
- \$50 provides emergency services to an adult in need

### **Habitat for Humanity of Greater Richmond**

- \$10 provides energy efficient compact fluorescent light bulbs
- \$25 provides a mail box
- \$50 provides a set of electric smoke detectors with battery back-up

### **HELP the Animals Shelter**

- \$10 provides preventative vaccinations for one pet
- \$25 sponsors a pet for January, providing food and warm safe housing during the coldest month
- \$50 provides spay/neuter for one pet to help end the cycle of homeless pets

### **Indiana Women in Need**
